

VIGNOBLES PALATIN GUIBERT

CHATEAU PALATIN

AOC SAINT EMILION GRAND CRU

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

Located in the heart of the Saint-Emilion vineyards, Château Palatin benefits from privileged southern exposure as well as a wide variety of terroirs ranging from clays to gravel, and including areas with more silt or limestone.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Merlot : 80% Cabernet Franc : 20%

WINEMAKING PROCESS

This wine is vinified in a large number of small, temperature-controlled concrete tanks to respect the cru's great diversity of terroirs using strict plot-by-plot vinification.

SAINT-EMILION GRAND CRU

This wine is aged in new or one-year old oak barrels for 14 to 18 months. At least 30% of the harvest remains in tanks to retain substantial aromatic freshness during the blending stage.

TASTING

This complex, intense wine contains black fruit aromas and spicy, grilled notes. On the palate, it reveals great depth provided by noticeable but smooth tannins for a balanced wine with a long, elegant finish. Its aromatic complexity and richness make it enjoyable with sauce-based dishes, spicy meat, and game such as pigeon with ceps.

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
